## YMCA Camp Medication Requirements

**Should your child have an allergy, asthma and/or need medication administered to them or any other need for rescue medications please read the Medication Requirements that follow:**

No child will be permitted into the camp without meeting the following requirements.

- a. Medications need to be in the original box with a doctor's action plan and labeled clearly with the child's name and expiration date.
- b. A signed and dated note giving permission the YMCA to administer the medication and for when(days, dates and time) the medication should be administered.
- c. In the case of an epinephrine pen, TWO are required to be at the camp with the child. Please send Benadryl if needed also.
- d. Must meet all medication requirements by the first day of camp.

Thank you for your understanding in this matter. It is our utmost priority to keep all children safe while under our care at the YMCA of Montclair. You can bring all the above in a labeled Ziploc bag and give to your child's counselor/director at drop off on the first day.
