Respect

Player is positive about abilities; takes mistakes and failures in stride; is self motivated; is not easily discouraged. Player encourages teammates, shakes hands with opponents; doesn't argue with officials; listens to coaches; doesn't make negative statements about opponents, officials or teammates.

Responsibility

Player attends and works hard in each practice, follows directions from coach; shows good focus; maintains self control. Player works well in a group; shares responsibilities with equipment, doesn't get discouraged if others around him/her do poorly; is a team player.

Honesty

Player is to follow the rules of the game and team with or without supervision. Player should not push rules to the limit and make excuses for breaking them. Player admits when he/she is working hard or not; acknowledges when he/she makes a mistake.

Caring

Player assists or takes turns with others with little or no prompting; includes everyone in a win; doesn't blame others for a loss or unsuccessful attempt; does not gloat in victory. We win and lose as a team. Player shows consideration for others welfare above all; able to comfort teammates when they get hurt or fail at a task. Shows concern for others without the need for reward or reinforcement.
