Lake Swimming and Fun Water Activities

Your summer camp experience wouldn't be complete without taking a dip in our beautiful freshwater lake. Campers get to cool off by enjoying lots of lake time. Water safety is the Y's #1 priority, so campers are scheduled for swim lessons Tuesday through Thursday, with free swim on Friday. Our American Red Cross Certified Lifeguards test every camper's swim ability before they hop in the lake, placing them at the correct swim level. Our group lessons are inspired by the National YMCA Progressive Swim Lesson Program. Our lake is the 'central hub' of the excitement, action, and learning. Kayaks, canoes, pedal boats, and paddle boards are campers' favorites, with 'walking on water' on the much loved Wibit[®] being the biggest hit. Spending time in and around our lake adds great value, and helps build confidence and life skills in campers, one splash at a time!

CAMP AT THE LAKE SPECIALTY CAMPS These camps are held at the same location as Traditional Camp and campers travel on their regular bus. Specialty Camps are designed

The Quest Summer Program is a 2-week experience designed to guide teens ages 14-16 to become future camp counselors. Teens will learn essential leadership skills and build self-confidence for life and the workforce. Teens will receive the following topics in their preparation: Introduction to the Y, History, Mission, and Core Values, Camp Program Expectations, Camp Program Scenarios Teamwork, Communication, Cooperation, Attitude, and Motivation.

Week 1 will focus on developing knowledge and skills. Week 2 will be an internship at either Camp at the Lake or New Discoveries.

HOW TO REGISTER

Go to *montclairymca.org/camps* Choose Your Camp and click on the register button. A credit card is required to register online.

MEMBERSHIP

A current YMCA of Montclair Youth/Teen/Family Membership is required to register. If you do not have a family membership and will register multiple children for camp using youth or teen memberships, please contact the Y at 973-744-3400 so the accounts can be merged ensuring a smooth registration process.

DEPOSITS/PAYMENTS

A \$75 deposit is due for each camp session, and a \$35 deposit is due for each Before Care and After Care session selected at the time of registration. Please note that camp session deposits and After Care deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable.

SIBLING DISCOUNT:

A 10% sibling discount will be applied to the child with the lowest camp tuition. If you are eligible for this discount, please contact us at campregistrar@ montclairymca.org after you have completed the registration process.

BALANCE: All accounts must be void of outstanding balances.

CHANGES/CANCELATIONS:

In order to discontinue scheduled payments and receive a full refund (MINUS the deposit), families must notify the YMCA of Montclair in writing of any cancelations 2 weeks prior to the beginning of the canceled camp session. Any cancelation notification later than 2 weeks prior to the beginning of the canceled camp session will NOT be refunded. Submit request to campregistrar@montclairymca.org.
