ROAD CLOSURES

The following roads will be closed on Sunday, June 1 from 5:30am to 11:00am:

- Park Street between Bloomfield Avenue and Claremont Avenue

The following roads will have limited access:

- Montague Place between Park Street and Valley Road
- Walnut Street/Chestnut Street/Claremont Avenue at Midland Avenue (police officers will control traffic)
- Central Avenue between James Street and Walnut Street
- James Street between Midland Avenue and Central Avenue
- Midland Avenue from Bloomfield Avenue to Watchung Avenue
- Erwin Park Road between Holland Terrace and Brunswick Road
- Central Avenue between Brunswick Road and Valley Road
- Brookfield Road between Edgemont Road and Valley Road
- The entire length of Oakcroft Avenue
