

# YMCA OF MONTCLAIR CHILD WATCH/KIDS CLUB HANDBOOK

Welcome to Child Watch/Kids Club! We want your child's stay to be a safe and positive experience. Each child is regarded as a unique individual who needs to be understood, guided, encouraged, and appreciated. This program provides opportunities for socialization and engaging, age-appropriate recreational activities. Child Watch is available for members and participants ages 6 months to 7 years, while Kids Club is for those ages 8 to 12. Children can remain in our care for a maximum of 2 hours, and parents/guardians must stay on YMCA premises while their child is in the program.

#### **Drop-off and Pick-up Procedure:**

Parents/guardians are required to personally drop off their children and stay within the Park Street YMCA facility while their children are in Child Watch/Kids Club. Parents/guardians are required to pre-register through MotionVibe and check in with a staff member upon arrival. Parents may check on their child at any time. To ensure the safety of all children in Child Watch/Kids Club, only YMCA staff are allowed to enter the space during regular operating hours; parents and other non-staff individuals are not permitted.

# **Capacity:**

Child Watch/Kids Club is not licensed by the Office for Childcare Services; however, the adult-to-child ratio is carefully monitored to ensure safety. The YMCA of Montclair reserves the right to limit the number of children in the room at any given time.

# Child Watch Hours\* (as of September, 2024):

Tuesday, Wednesday, and Saturday from 8am-12pm Monday-Thursday from 4pm-8pm Friday and Saturday CLOSED

# Kids Club Hours\* (as of September, 2024):

Tuesday and Thursday from 4pm- 8pm Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday CLOSED \*PLEASE NOTE: Hours and availability are subject to change on holidays and special events.

### **Pricing:**

FREE for Family Members \$10/hour per child for Individual Members Limit of 2 hours, register by hour time blocks

(\$1.00 per minute after the 2-hour limit or after closing time, due immediately).

### **Illnesses/Contagious Conditions:**

To maintain the health and safety of all children in our care, any child showing signs of illness or a contagious condition—such as coughing, diarrhea, vomiting, discolored nasal discharge, fever, or head lice—will not be permitted to remain in Child Watch/Kids Club.

### **Dress:**

Appropriate clothing and footwear must be worn at all times in the Child Watch/ Kids Club areas.

# Child Watch Bathroom/Diaper Policy:

Staff do not change diapers and are not permitted to assist children while using the restroom. If your young child is not potty-trained or unable to use the restroom independently, please ensure they are dressed in a pull-up upon arrival. Staff will locate parents/guardians immediately to change soiled diapers and/or clothing. A changing table will be available.

#### Kids Club Bathroom Policy:

Parents must ensure children use the bathroom upon arrival. If a child needs to use the bathroom during programming, a staff member will escort them to the nearest restroom.

# Play and Activity Time:

During programming, children are encouraged to participate in enriching and engaging activities featuring a variety of age-appropriate toys, equipment, and materials. If your child requires specific accommodations due to diverse abilities, please contact staff.

#### Snacks and Drinks:

Small snacks are permitted in Child Watch/Kids Club. If a child needs a snack during their time there, they may sit at a table to eat. Water is allowed and encouraged, provided it is in a labeled water bottle.

#### **Personal Items:**

For safety reasons, the use of electronics, including cellphones, iPads, and other devices is strongly discouraged. If your child requires accommodations due to diverse abilities, please contact staff.

### **Behavior:**

Child Watch/Kids Club is designed to create a pleasant and memorable experience for all children. Staff use redirection and positive reinforcement when working with all children in their care. If these methods are ineffective and a child poses a risk to themselves or others, staff will promptly notify parents/guardians in person or by telephone. Behavioral concerns will be shared with parents/guardians upon request. Biting, hitting, running, climbing, or pushing are not permitted in Child Watch/Kids Club. If a child struggles to adjust for 15 minutes, staff will ask parents/guardians to pick them up for their comfort and well-being. In the event of a second incident, staff will develop an action plan with parents/guardians. The YMCA of Montclair reserves the right to limit Child Watch/Kids Club access due to behavioral concerns.

We appreciate your careful review and consideration of this protocol. Your children are special to us, and we want to provide a fun, healthy, and safe place for them to play, learn, and connect.
